RPIRG leads other student organizations on campus by putting a strong emphasis on good governance and is committed to supporting the ongoing learning and development of its Board of Directors. As a volunteer board, directors contribute significant time, energy, and expertise to guide the organization, and RPIRG believes it is important to invest in their continued growth and community leadership. Professional development opportunities help ensure that board members are well-equipped to fulfill their governance responsibilities and make informed decisions in support of RPIRG's mission and strategic objectives.

During the 2025–2026 fiscal year, board-related expenses supported a range of governance and professional development activities. A major highlight was the Board and staff retreat to Vancouver and Victoria, which included two days of training with [Shake Up the Establishment](#), a national grassroots youth-led organization. The training focused on community organizing, climate justice, and social justice, while the retreat also created space for strategic discussions, relationship-building, and reflection on RPIRG's future priorities.

Other expenses included meals and refreshments provided during Board meetings. Expenses also included RPIRG's subscription to Boardable, an online governance platform used to manage meetings, share documents, maintain records, and support effective communication among directors.
